Na osnovu člana 6 stav 1 tačka 10, a u vezi sa članom 23 stav 2 Zakona o vazdušnom saobraćaju ("Službeni list CG", br. 30/12 i 30/17), Agencija za civilno vazduhoplovstvo donijela je:

Ovaj sigurnosni nalog primjenjuje se na:

- Operatora vazduhoplova čije se sjedište i/ili prebivalište nalazi na teritoriji države koja nije država članica EU, i
- Operatora vazduhoplova čije se sjedište i/ili prebivalište nalazi na teritoriji države članice EU, a koji namjerava da pruža usluge iz vazduha vazduhoplovima na koje se ne primjenjuje Uredba Evropskog parlamenta i Savjeta (EZ) br. 216/2008 od 20. februara 2008. godine o osnovnim pravilima u oblasti civilnog vazduhoplovstva i osnivanju Evropske agencije za sigurnost vazdušnog saobraćaja.

In accordance with Article 6, paragraph 1, point 10, in conjunction with Article 23 paragraph 2 of the Law on Air Transport ("Official Gazette of Montenegro", No. 30/12 and 30/17), the Agency for Civil Aviation, issued:

SAFETY ORDER**Number: 2012/001-Rev 03****Scope:**

This Safety Order applies to:

- Aircraft operator whose main office or registered office is at the territory of non-EU Member State, and
- Aircraft operator whose main office and/or registered office is at the territory of the EU Member State, which intends to perform aerial work operations with aircraft exempted from compliance with Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council (EC) No. 216/2008 from 20 February 2008 on common rules in the field of civil aviation and establishing a European Aviation safety Agency.

Regulation Reference:

Law on Air Transport ("Official Gazette of Montenegro", No. 30/12 and 30/2017)

Regulation on method, rules and procedures for flight operations and operational air traffic services ("Official Gazette of Montenegro", No. 11/2016), transposing Commission Regulation 923/2012 from 26 September 2012, laying down the common rules of the air and operational provisions regarding services and procedures in air navigation.

<p>Referentna dokumenta:</p> <p>ICAO Aneks 6 (Operacije vazduhoplova) Dio II (Međunarodna opšta avijacija – Avioni), Dio III Sekcija III (Međunarodna opšta avijacija – Helikopteri)</p> <p>Svrha:</p> <p>Ovim nalogom utvrđuje se postupak odobravanja pružanja usluga iz vazduha stranim operatorima vazduhoplova u vazdušnom prostoru Crne Gore u cilju zaštite sigurnosti vazdušnog saobraćaja.</p> <p>1. Uvod</p> <p>Strani operator vazduhoplova koji namjerava da pruža usluge iz vazduha u vazdušnom prostoru Crne Gore mora da ima odobrenje Agencije za civilno vazduhoplovstvo. Odobrenje se izdaje za pružanje komercijalnih i nekomercijalnih usluga iz vazduha.</p> <p>Izrazi u ovom nalogu imaju sljedeće značenje:</p> <p>1) Strani operator vazduhoplova je pravno ili fiziko lice koji vrši operacije vazduhoplovom ili namjerava da vrši operacije vazduhoplovom u vazdušnom prostoru Crne Gore a čije sjedište i/ili prebivalište se ne nalazi u Crnoj Gori ili EU ili čije se sjedište i/ili prebivalište nalazi na teritoriji države članice EU, a koji namjerava da pruža usluge iz vazduha vazduhoplovima na koje se ne primjenjuje Uredba Evropskog parlamenta i Savjeta (EZ) br. 216/2008 od 20. februara 2008. godine, koja je preuzeta Pravilnikom o osnovnim pravilima u oblasti civilnog vazduhoplovstva i nadležnostima Evropske agencije za sigurnost vazdušnog saobraćaja ("Službeni list CG", br. 22/13 i 15/17).</p> <p>2) Pružanje usluga iz vazduha su operacije vazduhoplova kojima se pružaju usluge u poljoprivredi, šumarstvu, građevinarstvu, protiv požarnoj zaštiti, protiv gradnoj odbrani, potrazi i spašavanju, marketingu, snimanju iz vazduha, nadzoru i patroliranju iz vazduha, provjeri radionavigacionih uređaja i sl.</p> <p>2. Izdavanje odobrenja za pružanje usluga iz vazduha stranim operatorima vazduhoplova</p> <p>2.1. Strani operator vazduhoplova podnosi Agenciji zahtjev za izdavanje odobrenja za pružanje usluga iz vazduha, na obrascu iz Priloga 1 ovog naloga, koji sadrži:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • naziv, adresu i kontakt detalje operatora ili vlasnika vazduhoplova, • IATA/ICAO kod (ukoliko je primjenjivo), 	<p>Documents Reference:</p> <p>ICAO Annex 6 (Operation of aircraft) Part II (International General Aviation – Aeroplanes), Part III Section III (International General Aviation – Helicopters)</p> <p>Purpose:</p> <p>This Order has prescribed the requirements for obtaining approval of aerial work operations performed by foreign aircraft operators in airspace of Montenegro in order to protect aviation safety.</p> <p>1. Introduction</p> <p>Foreign aircraft operator who intends to perform aerial work operations in airspace of Montenegro shall have the approval issued by the Civil Aviation Agency. Approval is issued for commercial and non-commercial aerial work operations.</p> <p>For the purpose of this Order, the following terms mean:</p> <p>1) Foreign Aircraft Operator is a legal or natural person who performs or intends to perform operations with aircraft in airspace of Montenegro whose head office and/or registered office is not in Montenegro or the EU or whose head office and/or registered office is located at the territory of the EU member State, and which intends to conduct aerial work operations with aircraft exempted from compliance with Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council (EC) No. 216/2008 from 20 February 2008 transposed by the Regulation on common rules in the field of civil aviation and the competences of the European Aviation Safety Agency ("Official Gazette of Montenegro", No. 22/13 and 15/17).</p> <p>2) Aerial Work Operations are aircraft operations where aircraft are used to provide services in agriculture, forestry, construction, fire-fighting, cloud seeding, search and rescue, aerial advertisement, photography, observation and patrol, testing radio-navigation systems/devices and similar.</p> <p>2. Issuance of approvals for aerial work operations to foreign aircraft operators</p> <p>2.1. The foreign aircraft operator shall submit to the Agency an application for approval of aerial work operations, in the form provided in Annex 1 of this Order, which contains:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Name, address and contact details of aircraft operator or owner, • IATA/ICAO designator (if applicable),

Strani operator vazduhoplova uz zahtjev iz podtačke 2.1 ove tačke prilaže kopije sljedećih dokumenata:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • važeći Certifikat ili ekvivalentni dokument kojim se operatoru vazduhoplova odobrava pružanje usluga iz vazduha izdat od strane države operatora (ukoliko je primjenljivo), • operativne specifikacije ili ekvivalentni dokument izdat od strane države operatora (napomena: područje operacija mora pokrivati područje teritorije Crne Gore) (ukoliko je primjenljivo), • potvrdu o registraciji, • važeće Uvjerenje o plovđbenosti vazduhoplova sa važećom Potvrdom o provjeri plovđbenosti, • važeće dozvole i ovlašćenja članova letačke posade koji učestvuju u operacijama, • važeće polise osiguranja od odgovornosti za štetu nastalu trećim licima izdatu shodno zahtjevima Uredbe EC 785/2004, • Ugovor zaključen između naručioca usluga iz vazduha i operatora stranog vazduhoplova (bez finansijskih detalja), • Uvjerenje o buci vazduhoplova (kada se zahtijeva), • Operativni priručnik ili standardne operativne procedure (SOP) na engleskom jeziku, • po potrebi i druga dokumenta od značaja za obavljanje operacija koje se smatraju relevantnim za procjenu rizika, povezanih sa izvođenjem operacija (npr. dokaz o modifikacijama vazduhoplova, održavanju i sl.) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reference number of valid Certificate approving aerial work operations issued to aircraft operator for aerial work operations, by the State of operator (if applicable), • Aircraft type and serial number, • Number of passengers' seats, • Aircraft registration mark, • Maximum Take-off Mass (MTOM), • Time period to be covered by approval, • Type of operation, • Area of planned operation(s), • Airport take-off and landing (arrival/departure from Montenegro), • Name of client/service user (if applicable), • Pilot(s) information. <p>2.2. In addition to the application specified in 2.1, the aircraft operator shall enclose copies of following documents:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Valid Certificate or equivalent document issued to aircraft operator approving aerial work operations, issued by the State of operator (if applicable), • Operational specifications or equivalent issued by the State of operator (note: area of operation must cover the territory of Montenegro) (if applicable), • Certificate of registration, • Valid Certificate of Airworthiness and the associated Airworthiness Review Certificate, • Valid licences and ratings for the flight crew members involved in operations, • Valid third party liability insurance policy issued pursuant to requirements of EC Regulation No. 785/2004, • Contract between client and foreign aircraft operator of aerial work operations (financial details excluded), • Aircraft noise certificate (as appropriate), • Operational Manual, or Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) in English language, • As appropriate, other documents important for performing operations which are considered relevant to the risk assessment, related to performance of operations (e.g. evidence of modification to the aircraft, maintenance and similar).

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Odobrenje za snimanje iz vazduha teritorije Crne Gore izdato od strane Ministarstva odbrane, ako se usluge iz vazduha pružaju radi snimanja teritorije Crne Gore. <p>Strani operator vazduhoplova je dužan da podnese Agenciji zahtjev za izdavanje posebnog odobrenja za letenje ispod minimalne sigurne visine, za letove ispod mostova i sličnih građevina, dalekovoda i antena, kao i za izbacivanje predmeta ili drugih stvari iz vazduhoplova u letu, vanaerodromska polijetanja i slijetanja, te druge operacije za koje je, saglasno propisima Crne Gore, potrebno posebno odobrenje, u skladu sa Pravilnikom o načinu, pravilima i postupcima letenja vazduhoplova i operativnim uslugama u vazdušnom saobraćaju („Službeni list CG“, broj 11/16).</p>	<p>Approval for air filming of the territory of Montenegro issued by the Ministry of Defence, in case the purpose of aerial work operations is video recording of the territory of Montenegro.</p> <p>Foreign aircraft operator shall submit the application for special approval for flight below minimum safety altitude, for flights below bridges and similar constructions, high voltage cables and antennas, as well as for dropping objects or other items from the aircraft in flight, out od the aerodrome take offs and landings, and other operations for which, under the regulations of Montenegro, the special approval is required, pursuant to the Regulation on method, rules and procedures for flight operations and operational air traffic services (“Official Gazette of Montenegro”, No. 11/2016).</p>
<p>3. Rok za podnošenje i evaluacija zahtjeva</p> <p>3.1. Zahtjev za izdavanje odobrenja za pružanje usluga iz vazduha, sa potrebnom dokumentacijom dostavlja se Agenciji najkasnije petnaest dana prije planiranog početka pružanja usluga. Nakon razmatranja dokumentacije i sprovedene analize rizika utvrđuje se ispunjenost uslova za izdavanje odobrenja za pružanje usluga iz vazduha.</p> <p>3.2. Agencija može da odluči da, prije izdavanja odobrenja za pružanje usluga iz vazduha, izvrši neposredni pregled kako bi utvrdila da li je moguće sigurno pružanje usluga iz vazduha. Nakon izdavanja navedenog odobrenja, Agencija može u svako doba da sproveđe inspekcijski pregled nad pružanjem usluga iz vazduha i kontrolu ispunjenosti uslova na osnovu kojih je izdato odobrenje za pružanje usluga iz vazduha.</p> <p>3.3. Odobrenje iz tačke 2 ovog naloga izdaje Agencija na ograničeni period važenja i može da sadrži uslove i ograničenja za vršenje operacija pružanja usluga iz vazduha.</p>	<p>3. Due time for submission of applications and their evaluation</p> <p>3.1. Application for approval of aerial work operations, with required accompanying documents shall be submitted to the Agency no later than fifteen days before the scheduled start of aerial work operations. After consideration of documents and risk analysis, the compliance with requirements for approval shall be determined.</p> <p>3.2. Before issuing the approval, the Agency may decide to perform an on-site inspection to determine whether the aerial work operations can be performed safely. After the issuance of the stated approval, the Agency may conduct inspections of provided aerial work operations and compliance with the requirements pursuant to which the approval for aerial work operations is issued.</p> <p>3.3. Approval referred to in point 2 of this Order shall be issued by the Agency and it may contain requirements and limitations for performing aerial work operations.</p>
<p>4. Ukinjanje odobrenja za pružanje usluga iz vazduha</p> <p>Ukoliko, na osnovu sprovedene analize rizika, Agencija procijeni da nijesu ispunjeni kriterijumi za sigurno obavljanje operacija pružanja usluga iz vazduha i da strani operator vazduhoplova postupa protivno važećim propisima Crne Gore, kao i uslovima i ograničenjima utvrđenim u izdatom odobrenju, Agencija može da ukine ili suspenduje izdato odobrenje za pružanje usluga iz vazduha.</p>	<p>4. Revocation of the approval for aerial work operations</p> <p>If, on the basis if conducted risk assessment, the Agency evaluates that the criteria for safe performance of operations are not complied with and that the foreign aircraft operator acts against the applicable regulations of Montenegro, as well as conditions and limitations defined in issued approval, the Agency may revoke or suspend issued approval of aerial work operations.</p>

<p>5. Stupanje na snagu</p> <p>Ovaj sigurnosni nalog stupa na snagu osmog dana od dana objavljivanja na internet stranici Agencije.
