Na osnovu člana 6 stav 1 tačka 10, a u vezi sa članom 23 stav 1 Zakona o vazdušnom saobraćaju ("Službeni list CG", br. 30/12, 30/17 i 82/20), Agencija za civilno vazduhoplovstvo (u daljem tekstu: Agencija) donijela je:

Ovaj sigurnosni nalog primjenjuje se na:

- Operatora vazduhoplova čije se sjedište i/ili prebivalište nalazi na teritoriji države koja nije država članica EU, i
- Operatora vazduhoplova čije se sjedište i/ili prebivalište nalazi na teritoriji države članice EU, a koji namjerava da pruža usluge iz vazduha vazduhoplovima na koje se ne primjenjuje Uredba Evropskog parlamenta i Savjeta (EZ) br. 216/2008 od 20. februara 2008. godine o osnovnim pravilima u oblasti civilnog vazduhoplovstva i osnivanju Evropske agencije za sigurnost vazdušnog saobraćaja.

SAFETY ORDER**Number: 2012/001-Rev 04****Scope:**

This Safety Order applies to:

- Aircraft operator whose main office or registered office is at the territory of non-EU Member State, and
- Aircraft operator whose main office and/or registered office is at the territory of the EU Member State, which intends to perform aerial work operations with aircraft exempted from compliance with Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council (EC) No. 216/2008 from 20 February 2008 on common rules in the field of civil aviation and establishing a European Aviation safety Agency.

Svrha:

Ovim nalogom utvrđuje se postupak odobravanja pružanja usluga iz vazduha (specijalizovane operacije-DIO-SPO) i/ili obavljanja operacija helikopterima na moru (SPA.HOFO) i/ili obavljanja helikopterskih operacija vtlom (SPA.HHO) stranim operatorima vazduhoplova u vazdušnom prostoru Crne Gore u cilju zaštite sigurnosti vazdušnog saobraćaja.

1. Uvod

Strani operator vazduhoplova koji namjerava da pruža usluge iz vazduha (specijalizovane operacije-DIO-SPO) i/ili da obavlja operacije helikopterima na moru (SPA.HOFO) i/ili da obavlja helikopterske operacije vtlom (SPA.HHO) u vazdušnom prostoru Crne Gore mora da ima odobrenje Agencije za civilno vazduhoplovstvo. Odobrenje se izdaje za: pružanje komercijalnih i nekomercijalnih usluga iz vazduha (specijalizovane operacije-DIO-SPO) i/ili obavljanje operacija helikopterima na moru (SPA.HOFO) i/ili obavljanje helikopterskih operacija vtlom (SPA.HHO).

Izrazi upotrijebljeni u ovom nalogu imaju sljedeće značenje:

1) Strani operator vazduhoplova je pravno ili fiziko lice koji vrši operacije vazduhoplovom ili namjerava da vrši operacije vazduhoplovom u vazdušnom prostoru Crne Gore a čije sjedište i/ili prebivalište se ne nalazi u Crnoj Gori ili državi članici EU ili pravno ili fizičko lice čije se sjedište i/ili prebivalište nalazi na teritoriji države članice EU, a koji namjerava da pruža usluge iz vazduha vazduhoplovima na koje se ne primjenjuje Uredba Evropskog parlamenta i Savjeta (EZ) br. 216/2008 od 20. februara 2008. godine, koja je preuzeta Pravilnikom o osnovnim pravilima u oblasti civilnog vazduhoplovstva i nadležnostima Evropske agencije za sigurnost vazdušnog saobraćaja („Službeni list CG“, br. 22/13 i 15/17).

2) Pružanje usluga iz vazduha (specijalizovane operacije-DIO-SPO) su operacije vazduhoplova kojima se pružaju usluge u poljoprivredi, šumarstvu, građevinarstvu, protiv požarnoj zaštiti, protiv gradnoj odbrani, potrazi i

Purpose:

This Order has prescribed the requirements for obtaining approval of aerial work operations (specialised operations-PART-SPO) and/or helicopter offshore operations (SPA.HOFO) and/or helicopter hoist operations (SPA.HHO) performed by foreign aircraft operators in airspace of Montenegro in order to protect aviation safety.

1. Introduction

Foreign aircraft operator who intends to perform aerial work operations (specialised operations-PART-SPO) and/or helicopter offshore operations (SPA.HOFO) and/or helicopter hoist operations (SPA.HHO) in airspace of Montenegro shall have the approval issued by the Civil Aviation Agency. Approval is issued for: commercial and non-commercial aerial work operations (specialised operations-PART-SPO) and/or helicopter offshore operations (SPA.HOFO) and/or helicopter hoist operations (SPA.HHO).

For the purpose of this Order, the following terms mean:

1) Foreign Aircraft Operator is a legal or natural person who performs or intends to perform operations with aircraft in airspace of Montenegro whose head office and/or registered office is not in Montenegro or the EU or whose head office and/or registered office is located at the territory of the EU member State, and which intends to conduct aerial work operations with aircraft exempted from compliance with Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council (EC) No. 216/2008 from 20 February 2008 transposed by the Regulation on common rules in the field of civil aviation and the competences of the European Aviation Safety Agency (“Official Gazette of Montenegro”, No. 22/13 and 15/17).

2) Aerial Work Operations (specialised operations-PART-SPO) are aircraft operations where aircraft are used to provide services in agriculture, forestry, construction, fire-fighting, cloud seeding, search and rescue, aerial

3) Operacija na moru (HOFO) je operacije helikopterom koja ima pretežni dio svakog leta koji se odvija iznad površina otvorenog mora, prema ili od lokacije na moru.

4) Helikopterska operacija sa vitim (HHO) je operacija helikopterom čija je svrha omogućavanje prenošenja osoba i/ili tovara helikopterskim vitim;

2. Izdavanje odobrenja za: pružanje usluga iz vazduha (SPO) i/ili obavljanje HOFO operacija i/ili obavljanje HHO operacija stranim operatorima vazduhoplova

2.1. Strani operator vazduhoplova podnosi Agenciji zahtev za izdavanje odobrenja za: pružanje usluga iz vazduha (SPO) i/ili za obavljanje HOFO operacija i/ili za obavljanje HHO operacija, na obrascu iz Priloga 1 ovog naloga, koji sadrži:

- naziv, adresu i kontakt detalje operatora ili vlasnika vazduhoplova,
- IATA/ICAO kod (ukoliko je primjenjivo),
- broj važećeg certifikata kojim se odobrava operatoru stranog vazduhoplova pružanje usluga iz vazduha izdat od strane države operatora (ukoliko je primjenjivo),
- podatke o tipu vazduhoplova i serijski broj,
- broj putničkih sjedišta,
- registarsku oznaku vazduhoplova,
- najveću dopuštenu masu pri polijetanju (MTOM),
- vremenski period za koji se traži odobrenje,
- vrste operacija,
- područje na kojem se planira obavljanje operacija,
- izjavu o usklađenosti sa odgovarajućim dijelom Pravilnika o tehničkim zahtjevima i procedurama za obavljanje vazdušnih operacija (SPO, HOFO, HHO) (Preuzeta Uredba Komisije (EU) br. 965/2012),
- aerodrom polijetanja i slijetanja (ulaska/izlaska iz Crne Gore),
- naziv naručioca/korisnika usluge (ukoliko je primjenljivo),
- podatke o pilotima.

2.2. Strani operator vazduhoplova uz zahtjev iz podtačke 2.1 ove tačke prilaže kopije sljedećih dokumenata:

- važeći Certifikat vazdušnog operatora (AOC) ili ekvivalentni dokument kojim se operatoru

advertisement, photography, observation and patrol, testing radio-navigation systems/devices and similar.

3) Helicopter offshore operation (HOFO) means a helicopter operation that have a substantial proportion of any flight conducted over open sea areas to or from an offshore location

4) Helicopter hoist operation (HHO) means a flight by a helicopter, the purpose of which is to facilitate the transfer of persons and/or cargo by means of a helicopter hoist

2. Issuance of approvals for: aerial work operations (SPO) and/or HOFO and/or HHO operations to foreign aircraft operators

2.1. The foreign aircraft operator shall submit to the Agency an application for approval of: aerial work operations (SPO) and/or HOFO and/or HHO operations, in the form provided in Annex 1 of this Order, which contains:

- Name, address and contact details of aircraft operator or owner,
- IATA/ICAO designator (if applicable),
- Reference number of valid Certificate approving aerial work operations issued to aircraft operator for aerial work operations, by the State of operator (if applicable),
- Aircraft type and serial number,
- Number of passengers' seats,
- Aircraft registration mark,
- Maximum Take-off Mass (MTOM),
- Time period to be covered by approval,
- Type of operation,
- Area of planned operation(s),
- Statement of compliance with applicable part of Regulation laying down technical requirements and administrative procedures related to air operations (SPO, HOFO, HHO) (transposing Commission Regulation (EU) No 965/2012)
- Airport take-off and landing (arrival/departure from Montenegro),
- Name of client/service user (if applicable),
- Pilot(s) information.

2.2. In addition to the application specified in 2.1, the aircraft operator shall enclose copies of following documents:

- Valid Air Operator Certificate (AOC) or equivalent document issued to aircraft
